Owaneco Lodge Code of Conduct

On my honor, I promise to do my best to comply with the Owaneco Lodge Code of Conduct, for the sake of the lodge, my fellow Scouts, and the Connecticut Yankee Council.

- I will do my best to live up to the Scout Oath, Scout Law, and the Order of the Arrow Obligation, and hold others in Scouting accountable to those standards. I will exercise sound judgement and demonstrate good leadership, and I will use the Scouting program for its intended purpose consistent with the mission of Scouting America and the Order of the Arrow.
- 2. I will not threaten, fight, or intimidate another member through words or actions, nor will I use language that is offensive or discriminatory with respect to sex, race, religion, ethnicity, physical/mental disability, etc.
- 3. I will attend the planned program sessions.
- 4. I understand that gatherings of 2 or more youth outside of the scheduled program location must always have 2 deep adult leadership.
- 5. I will always follow the buddy system, which consists of two members of the same gender.
- 6. I will observe quiet hours and 11:00 pm lights out as per the event schedule.
- 7. I will wear suitable, activity appropriate clothing and footwear at all times during the event. During Ceremonies, Dinner and Evening Program I will attend in Field Uniform.
- 8. I will keep my sleeping quarters clean and orderly and dispose of trash in proper receptacle.
- 9. I understand the camp sites are assigned at registration. No one should enter another campsite in respect of other members' privacy and possessions. If on a service project, work may be done in a site, but no one should go into the sleeping quarters of another member.
- 10. I will not leave camp without permission of the event adult leadership.
- 11. I will park only in designated areas unless approved.
- 12. I will be personally responsible for breakage, damage, or loss of property.
- 13. I will not possess or consume any tobacco products, alcohol products, controlled substances, firearms, fireworks, or explosives at Owaneco events and understand that possession of any of these could result in legal consequences.
- 14. I will abide by the BSA Guide to Safe Scouting <u>www.scouting.org/health-and-safety/gss/</u>

I understand that participants (Youth & Adult) failing to adhere to the stated terms may be dismissed from the event, forgoing any refund of event fees, and could result in dismissal from the OA Lodge, and/or Scouting. Adult leadership will inform parents (if under 18) and provide documentation of offense(s). I understand that I am responsible for reporting participants who have disobeyed the rules to the Owaneco Lodge Adult Leadership.
